1830-2030 Team building exercises in the field, survival, first aid, basic mountaineering, Intro to Night Vision

1300-1630 Squad Operations (field), Home Defense Consideration, Dismounted Patrolling Basics, React to Contact Drills, think fast, act deliberately, How to move with the entire group integrated as a unit Land Navigation as squads, Leading into unfamiliar territory

1815-2100 Classroom Leadership Lessons (Classroom), Troop Leading Procedures and The Planning Process

2100-2200 Fireside Leadership Lesson Leadership lessons shared by all, Debrief and After Actions Review.

#### Putting it all together, The Decision Making Process and Taking Care of each other.

0700-0745 Breakfast, Brief, Blessing (Issue MRE one per student)

0800-1000 Troop Leading Procedures, The Decision Making Process, classroom

1000-1015 Break

1015-1030 Receive Mission: Begin TLPs and Decision Making Process, Mission Analysis, Issue Warning Order, Develop a tentative plan

1030-12:00 Continue TLPS

1200-1215 Lunch in field MRE

1215-1600 Continue with TLPS and Decision Making Process, Start Movement (one Team may move out early to conduct a Recon), Conduct Recon, Complete the Plan, Issue the order, Rehearse, Identify friction points.

1600-2100 GET IT ON! Execute Mission, Gear up, Safety checks, Issue blank ammo

1630-1800 Step off movement to objective, navigation, Leaders Recon, Adjust the plan, Back brief to ensure everyone knows the plan

1800-2100 Time on Target, Gather Pertinent Info required

2100-2200 Fireside Leadership Lesson Cut from the Same Cloth, Learning from our mistakes, Leadership Practices, class photograph
