**1800-1900** Sit-down Dinner at Stonewood Ranch

**1900-2000** Leadership Discussion Letter to Garcia (classroom) *1.5 hr*

**2030-2200** Night vision movement as squad (field) *1.5 hr*

**2200-2300** Fireside Debrief and After Actions Review *1 hr*

### TRAINING DAY 3

#### Execute! Execute! Execute!

**0700-0745** Breakfast, Daily Brief, Blessing

**0800-1000** Troop Leading Procedures, Decision Making Process, (classroom) *2 hrs*

**1000-1200** Receive Mission: Begin TLPs/ Decision Making Process (classroom) *2 hrs*

- Mission Analysis
- Issue Warning Order
- Develop a tentative plan

**1200-1230** Lunch in field MRE

**1230-1430** Continue with TLPS and Decision Making Process *2 hrs*.

Rehearse actions on objectives, Identify friction points.

**1430-1530** Final Inspections and mission prep.

**1600-2100** GET IT ON! Execute Mission *6.5 hrs*

**2100-2200** Movement to extraction point, casualty evacuation, return to base

**2200-2300** Fireside Leadership Lesson After Actions Review, Award presentations, Turn in Weapons

**2300** End of Day 3
